Dear Parent/Guardian,

Within our school community, there is a student who has a potentially life-threatening allergy (anaphylaxis) to food, predominantly to peanuts and tree nuts (e.g. almond, cashew, hazelnut, pistachio). This allergy can be transferred via person to person touch or by touching the surface another student has touched (i.e. library books, gym balls, playground equipment). It is our intention to ensure the safety of all students in our school.

In order to ensure the safety of this student, ECS students will not be allowed bring foods containing nuts or peanuts to school.

The rest of the school will become a nut-aware environment. As much as possible, please select foods that do not contain nuts or peanuts. If your children do bring foods containing nuts or peanuts, they are asked to advise their teachers so that safety measures can be taken to ensure accidental exposure to other students. They will be asked to carefully wash their hands, faces and eating surfaces after eating foods containing nut products.
